Online Safety

Location Services

Lots of apps that we use can monitor our location and allow us to 'check in' at a



location and share where we are.

It is important that you talk to your child about how they use the location settings within apps e.g. checking in at home or when they are out shows people where you live or are. Please reinforce that this is **personal information which should not be shared.**

You can control which apps can see and use your location by adjusting the settings. If your child has a mobile or mobile device with social media apps please talk to them and make sure location services are switched off.

One example of an app that uses your location is Snapchat through the Snap Map. The Map lets other uses see where their friends are if a friend has chosen to share their location.



Please be aware that, although is it a popular app with primary aged children: Snapchat has a sign up age of 13+
